Protocols at a Glance

For Spring 2022, please note the following:

All employees, students, visitors and vendors entering HLSCC Campus/Sites will be required to have their temperature taken at one of the designated locations:

- Security Desk of the Main Building
- Academic Services Building
- Student Success Centre
- Culinary Arts Centre
- Centre for Applied Marine Studies (CAMS)
- Virgin Gorda Centre Entryway

Electronic sign-in procedures are also required.

- Students, employees, and visitors are required to wear their masks upon entry to all College buildings and in public and shared spaces once in the presence of another individual.
- Where possible, appointments are to be made to access services or meet with College officers prior to coming to the College.
- Everyone is asked to perform a self-assessment before going to any College facility. If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms or situations, please remain at home and contact your instructor or supervisor:
 - Fever
 - Sore throat
 - Red/Pink eye
 - New or worsening shortness of breath
 - Chills and/or rigors
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Chest Pain
 - Known contact with someone who is lab-confirmed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days
 - Headache
 - Nasal congestion
 - New or worsening cough
 - Skin rash
 - Muscle pain
 - Nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea

Rapid Tests are available at the Campus Nurse's Office at a cost of \$40.

- If on campus and you become symptomatic, please leave work/class immediately.
- Faculty or supervisors can ask symptomatic individuals to leave or visit the Campus clinic.
- Arrangements can be made to be tested via PCR, by contacting Public Health at 468-3701 Ext. 2275, the Covid-19 Hotline at 852-7504 or your physician.
- If immediate departure is not possible, the affected individual will be isolated at a designated space until departure is possible.
- If the individual is very ill, the Campus Nurse should be contacted immediately at 542-7187.

Anyone who has tested positive will have to present a negative test result or quarantine release letter to the Nurse's Office (students) or the Human Resources Department (employees) before returning to class or work.
