Please be reminded that the first day of classes for the Fall 2021 Semester begins today, **August 25, 2021.**

Many of you may be asking the question - "Is my class online or must I come on campus for class?"

As HLSCC prepares to start the Fall 2021 semester still facing challenges from the recent spike in positive COVID-19 cases in the Territory, we continue to implement actions designed to protect the health and well-being of our employees and students, while still enabling the continuation of our services.

As such, **please be advised that classes that do not have a strong practical component -- therefore not requiring face-to-face contact-- will begin online on August 25**, for a four-to-six week period in the first instance, reviewable after three weeks or advised otherwise by your lecturer.

Classes that have a strong practical component, such as Automotive, Technical and Marine -- therefore requiring face-to-face contact -- will begin face-to-face classes on August 25 with limited class sizes. Culinary Arts face-to-face classes will begin on September 1st 2021.

If you're a student that falls under the category of a strong practical component class (Culinary Arts, Workforce, Automotive, and Marine) and you're still not sure, please contact your instructor(s) directly for confirmation.
